What does Freedom Truck Finance do with your personal information?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. The information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances and payment history
- Credit History and credit scores

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

All financial companies need to share customer’s personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers personal information; the reasons Freedom Truck Finance chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Freedom Truck Finance protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We restrict access to nonpublic personal information about you to employees who need that information to provide products or services to you.
How does Freedom Truck Finance collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • apply for financing • give us your income information or provide employment information • pay your bills or give us your contact information We also collect your personal information from theirs, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Freedom Truck Finance does not share with our affiliates.
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Freedom Truck Finance does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Freedom Truck Finance doesn't jointly market.

Other Important Information	
Vermont Residents: Under Vermont law, we will not share information we collect about Vermont residents with non-affiliates, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent or to service your accounts. We will not share information about your creditworthiness among our affiliates except with your consent, but we may share information about our transactions or experiences with you with our affiliates without your consent.	
California Residents: Under California law, we will not share information we collect about you with non-affiliates, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent or to service your accounts. We will limit sharing among our affiliates to the extent required by California law.
